

## **Immediate Report**

The Company is pleased to announce the nomination of Professor Roger D. Kornberg, Nobel Prize Laureate in Chemistry for the year 2006, as the **Scientific President of the Company**. Professor Kornberg won the Nobel Prize for his research and discoveries of the molecular basis of eukaryotic transcription (synthesis of RNA from a DNA template). Professor Kornberg is also one of the pioneers in membrane research, and a Key Opinion Leader in these fields. Trans-membrane drug delivery and genetic therapies are also the core of the *Apo-Si* R&D Program of the Company.

Professor Kornberg has been following the *Apo-Si* Project periodically, since its launch about years ago, and now, following the progress made in the Project, decided to accept the nomination as **Scientific President of the Company**.

The Company welcomes Prof. Kornberg, and believes that in light of his scientific achievements, expertise, and experience, the joining of Prof. Kornberg as the Company's Scientific President may markedly advance the Company's R&D activities in the fields of delivery of macromolecule drugs and genetic therapies.
